About this Opportunity

Actua has an immediate opening for an Outreach Content Creator in Ottawa, Ontario.

Actua is a national charity that delivers life-changing experiences to youth in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM). We achieve this through our network of member organizations located at universities and colleges across Canada and through our own Outreach Team that delivers STEM programming in areas not yet served by our network members.

We are looking for a highly motivated and creative STEM enthusiast who will work with our Outreach Team to develop and deliver locally and culturally relevant science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) programs. These include school workshops, summer camps, STEM, public events, and other initiatives as they arise. The majority of our Outreach Team programs are delivered in northern remote areas of the country, including the Arctic, and primarily in Indigenous communities.

This position will report to the Manager of Outreach.

Scope of work

The primary responsibilities in this position include:

- Development of the outreach curriculum taking direction from national staff, ensuring that Actua's standards of quality and pedagogical integrity are maintained at all times and that curriculum meets the unique circumstances of the outreach programming;
- Collaborate with communities, subject matter experts, and external partners to develop relevant STEM content for outreach programs;
- Assist other Actua teams such as the Education, InSTEM or Network Member Services teams with content development as needs arise;
- Facilitate training sessions on content for instructors, network members, or other programs as needed;
- Ensure safe and efficient storage of equipment and materials including maintaining an inventory systems for all technological equipment and,

maintaining an inventory of all other materials and equipment, as well as managing the organization and storage of above materials and equipment;

- Pilot new content and assist with troubleshooting and support while programs are being delivered;
- Deliver outreach programming locally in Ottawa and elsewhere in Canada when required, including traveling to rural and remote communities for extended periods of time;
- Participate in recruitment events, local festivals and/or conferences as they arise
- Contribute to the future of the program by participating in evaluation, providing feedback, and sharing success stories;
- Other duties as assigned by your Supervisor or CEO.

Qualifications

The ideal candidate is committed to supporting youth participation in STEM through life-changing experiences. Additional desired skills and experiences:

- Undergraduate degree (in related field: education, STEM, Indigenous studies);
- Experience developing and writing lesson plans and activities;
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills and superior written and oral communication skills;
- Knowledge of Actua's outreach programming and/or background in education or youth outreach;
- Strong attention to detail, flexibility and a high level of accountability;
- Organizational and documentation skills.

Assets

- Understanding of unique logistical travel challenges within rural/remote and Northern communities;
- Experience working respectfully with First Nations, Métis, and Inuit partners and communities;
- Bilingualism (French and English or Inuktitut and English).
