Fundraising (70% - 80%)

corporate and government funders. Leverage your writing expertise and strategic
thinking to secure vital funding for Actua's initiatives. Ensure proposals effectively
align with our mission, vision, and goals while captivating diverse audiences.

- Research and Identify Opportunities: Conduct comprehensive research to identify
 and assess STEM sectors that can benefit from Actua's partnership. Utilize external
 data and insights to build persuasive proposals that resonate with potential funders.
